Dear Parents/Guardians,

There is an upcoming community presentation called Rachel’s Challenge for parents on Tuesday, November 19 at 6:30 in the auditorium at TMS. The organization called Rachel’s Challenge will be visiting TMS and meeting with students and staff during the school day. Rachel's Challenge is an organization in the United States that works to reduce violence. It is a non-religious, non-profit, non-political organization, led by Darrell Scott and his wife Sandy. Rachel Scott was the first student killed in the Columbine High School shooting in 1999. Darrell Scott, Rachel's father, established Rachel's Challenge to perpetuate his daughter's example and the two-page "Code of Ethics" she wrote a month before her death at the hands of the perpetrators of the Columbine High School shooting. This code of ethics had included the words: "Compassion is the greatest form of love humans have to offer” and Darrell Scott has stated his belief in this message forms the basis for what he both speaks at public appearances, and has written as an author.

I hope you will be able to set aside time and join us for this powerful parent presentation on Tuesday, November 12 at 6:30 at our TMS auditorium.
