Campers will have an opportunity to learn from many outstanding high school and college coaches. The staff also includes current and former college players.



BILL GEITNER

The tenth coach in the history of the Eastern Connecticut State University men's basketball program, Bill Geitner has coached and won more games than any of the previous nine coaches, with no previous head coach in the 77-year history of the program having coached more than his 16 seasons.

En route to his eighth 20-win season in nine years in 2017/18, Geitner

led the Warriors to a record 26 wins against just four losses, their fifth straight Little East Conference regular-season title, second LEC tournament championship in a row, fourth NCAA tournament berth in five years and record No. 10 national ranking. For his efforts, he was selected NABC Northeast Region Coach-of-the-Year for the second time in seven years and LEC Coach-of-the-Year for the sixth time in nine seasons.

After winning the program's first Little East Conference tournament title since 2000 in 2011/12, Geitner orchestrated a run through the NCAA tournament which included a regional championship with victories over Medaille College and in double overtime, a buzzer-beating triumph over host SUNY Oswego.

At Eastern, Geitner has compiled an overall record of 275 wins and 171 losses for a .612 winning percentage. The most successful LEC program for nearly a decade, Eastern is 74-10 (.881) in LEC regular-season play since 2012/13 and has won its last 38 consecutive LEC regular-season games at Geissler Gymnasium over the last six years.
