SPECIAL BUDGET UPDATE

The unique budget situation this year has made things quite confusing for all involved. At 1:58 AM this morning the State of Connecticut Senate passed a budget. This is being labeled a “bi-partisan budget,” and passed 33-3. The State of Connecticut House will be debating it today. Initial information released to Towns indicates that Tolland is substantially better off with this recent budget plan than under other budget scenarios. The plan does not put Teacher Retirements on the Town budget, and along with other changes will likely provide for a more favorable budget situation. Information discussed with regard to the 2.5% budget going to referendum will change based on this new situation, this includes information discussed in the BOE meeting last night.

The Town Manager will be putting out a communication later today to highlight some of the new considerations with regard to the plan that is being debated in the House today. The Governor still has the option of vetoing this budget, but there also seems to be more bi-partisan support for this plan and a greater chance for success despite a veto.

I will provide additional information on considerations regarding the school district and the budget as soon as the Town Manager releases his press release.
