A student's grade level is the grade he or she has just completed in the 2018-2019 school year, sorry no exceptions.

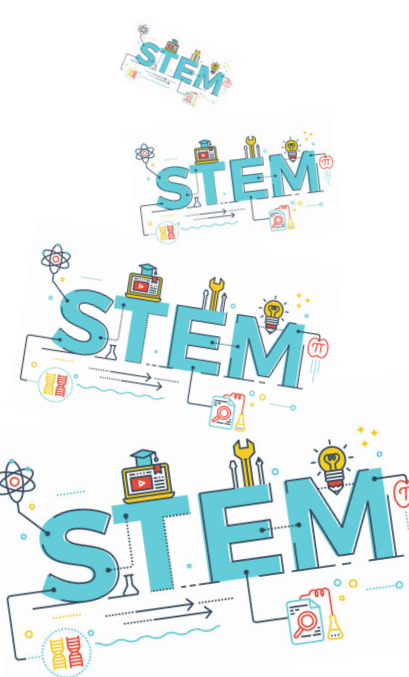

INSECT STEM EXPLORATION (GRADES K-2)



Do your kids like bugs? Then this class that focuses on science, engineering, and mathematics is for them! We will observe insects' symmetry and recreate it with mirrors and reflections. After studying a firefly's life cycle, we will build a simple circuit that lights up the insect. They will also get to bring home fingerprint insects and pipe cleaner insects to keep. We will go out for a nature walk and hang up our handmade butterfly feeders. We will daily revisit the feeders to see if any butterflies have visited. We will also experiment with pollination! To complete our two week insect adventure, we will invite a local beekeeper to come and visit our classroom to talk about his beehives!

STEM-TASTIC FIRST STEPS! (GRADES K-2)

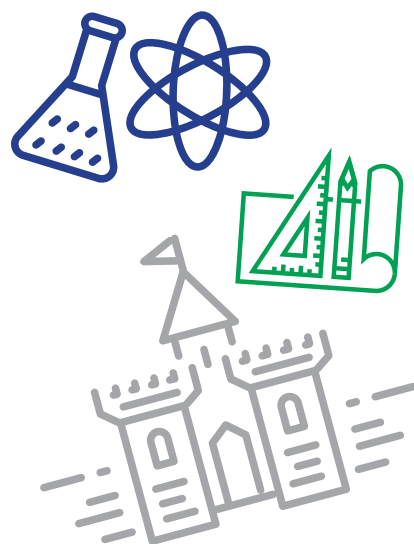
