# BOE BUDGET WORKSHOP TONIGHT: 7:30 PM in the Tolland High School Library

Tonight's meeting was originally about the 18-19 budget, however, we have a very serious budget situation unfolding at the state level that has a strong chance of impacting the 17-18 budget. Unfortunately, buried within the budget that was recently passed by the state were millions of dollars in budget "lapses" that the state leaders likely knew about but left to the Governor to remedy. The lapses are unspecified cuts that are included in budgets that assume that various line items will generate savings by the end of a budget year. Historically there have been some of these lapses (also referred to as "commission lapses") in prior budgets but nothing on the scale of what is being considered right now.

There has been some sentiment expressed that many of the state leaders were surprised that the Governor would make these 17-18 reductions part of municipal aid and ECS reductions. In addition, these "lapse" cuts are part of the current (17-18) state budget, they are not part of the potential future cuts needed to close a remaining 178 million dollar deficit. Bottom line, for Tolland, this could mean an *additional* reduction of about \$865k from ECS funding *this* year 17-18, in other words, right now. This is a serious problem for the Town and the school district. I encourage you to come tonight to hear an initial review and discussion of this situation.

Thousands of children each year spend days, weeks or longer in PJ's at the hospital while receiving care. *PJ Day for the Kids* will help us show our support for these brave kids!


