On Friday, February 9, senior **Ryan Greenberg** committed to continue his soccer career at the University of Connecticut. A four-year starter as defender at Tolland High School, Ryan won a Class M State Championship in his sophomore year and finished runner-up in his freshman year. Ryan was an All-State selection for two straight years and is considered one of the best defenders in the state. He plans on majoring in

Junior **Stephen Sutton** place sixth with a time of 2:33.89 in the 1000 meters at the 2018 Connecticut CIAC Indoor Track State Championships held at the Floyd Little Athletic Center in New Haven on Saturday, February 17. Sophomore **Tianna St. Louis** finished fifth in the girl's high jump with a height of 5 feet 4 inches. By placing in the top six, both Stephen and Tianna qualify for the New England High School Indoor Track and Field Championships which will be held at the Reggie Lewis Center in Roxbury, Massachusetts on Saturday, March 3.
