TOLLAND HIGH SCHOOL RELAY FOR LIFE

On Friday May 26, THS students and staff will come together as a community to remember loved ones lost, honor survivors of all cancer, and raise money to help the American Cancer Society's fight against cancer.

This school-wide event will be orchestrated by Tolland DECA students and will benefit and assist the goals of the American Cancer Society. Students in the club have volunteered their time and effort because they believe there is an overwhelming need to take action against cancer. As Relay For Life is the signature fundraiser for the American Cancer Society, the goal is to raise at least \$10,000.

Since the fundraiser will be held during the school day, **Honor Ribbons** will be sold online to celebrate every life touched by cancer rather than the luminarias often seen at night. You can dedicate them to a loved one lost, someone currently battling, or anyone who's overcome it. If you desire to attend the Tolland High School Relay for Life event, you'll see the Honor Ribbons decorated with names and messages to the people they're dedicated to. Relay participants share an emotional moment when each Honor Ribbon is posted in remembrance of a life touched by cancer. Together, we will take a moment of silence to remember the loved ones they're dedicated to. When you make a donation for a Honor Ribbon it helps fund the American Cancer Society and Tolland High School's mission to help save precious lives. STUDENTS MUST REMAIN IN THE EXAM FOR THE ENTIRE 90 MINUTES.

- Students excused or exempt from exams do not need to report to school.\

- Students who are in school and not taking exams must be in the cafeteria while exams are in progress. A student may be in the library but must make arrangements with the library staff in advance to do so.
- The make-up exam period is only for those students who have special problems approved in advance by the department chairperson.
- All students are expected to be in their exams on time. Forgetting, sleeping late, etc. are not excuses for missing a final exam.
- Students who have just one exam on either day only need to be here for their exam period. For example, if you have only a Block 1 exam and you have your own transportation, you may leave after the end of the Block 1 exam period. The reverse is also true. If you have only a Block 2 exam and you are able to provide your own transportation to school, you do not need to be here during the Block 1 exam period. However, you must be on time to the Block 2 exam period.
- Students are not to leave the school building in between exam periods if they have two exams on the same day.
- Buses will arrive and depart school at the regularly scheduled time on Thursday, June 15, 2017. Buses will depart at 10:45 a.m. on Friday, June 16th. There will be no late bus.

THE BANNER PROJECT

Banners are to be returned to the main office NO LATER than June 8th. No late banners will be accepted.

GRADUATION

Graduation will be held at 6:00 p.m. in the THS Gymnasium. Seniors will be given a packet at their senior assembly on May 2 with all the information needed for their senior activities. Seniors will be given 8 tickets to graduation on the morning of graduation at rehearsal. Students must attend rehearsal to participate in graduation.
