Community Security Update

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you back to Union Hill ISD for the 2022-2023 school year. We are very excited about the great things we are going to accomplish this year. As you may know, there are many updates for schools concerning on and off campus security. Please know, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority. In accordance with TEA directives and state law, we are implementing many security measures that will impact every campus. The first thing you will notice is that our access points and procedures to gain entry into the campus have changed. Bus drop off for students will be between the junior high and high school building. All other student drop off, for all campuses, will be at the elementary building. High school and Junior High students will access the courtyard through the breezeway between the library and the elementary school. Elementary students will enter through the front elementary school doors. There will no longer be access to the campuses using the east high school entrance. All visitors to the central admin office, high school, and elementary campuses will enter through the elementary office. We will be installing the Raptor System to scan driver licenses of every guest that enters the district. This is being done to establish 1 secure point of entry for all district's facilities.

Secondly, the gate on the northwest side of the football field will be locked at 8:00am and unlocked at 3:00pm for parent pickup. All guests will need to enter the campus via the northeast gate during this time. The student parking lot area is off limits to all guests from 7am to 4pm. Visitors will no longer be allowed to drive into the central admin office area during the school day. This area, along with the access point to the courtyard, will be gated off during the school day. If you need to visit the central administrative office, you will need to park in front of the elementary campus and enter through the elementary office. We understand that some of these changes will be an inconvenience. Again, our most important responsibility is the safety of our students and staff. We ask that you please understand the necessity of these changes as we move forward. School security is all of our responsibility. Together we can and will provide safe and secure campuses at Union Hill ISD.
